Doug Stanglin USA TODAY The United Nations Security Council adopted unanimously a resolution Monday condemning the assassination of former Lebanese prime minister Rafik Hariri and demanding "the immediate arrest and trial of the perpetrators" for the crime. The resolution also condemned the violence that followed the assassination and called for "the peaceful, rapid and unconditional withdrawal of all Lebanese armed forces from Lebanese territory." "This event is a stark reminder of the resilience of Lebanon's democratic institutions and resilience of the Lebanese people," said U.S. Ambassador Samantha Power, who sponsored the resolution, before it was adopted. "This is a day of loss and of mourning, and it is not just a day of loss for the people of Lebanon and for the people of Lebanon's political class. It is a day of loss for the United Nations, for the people of the world, for the people of Lebanon's democratic future." Her voice choking up, Power added: "This has been a year of loss for Lebanon, and it has not been a year of progress. What we saw today was an illustration of how real and how terrible that loss is." The resolution also reaffirmed the "continuing responsibility of the Lebanese state and its security forces to ensure the protection of the country's civilians against the threat posed by Hezbollah and other militias," a reference to the Iran-backed group that has long been allied with the Shiite militant group. "The Council has acted with one voice today to condemn the heinous assassination of Mr. Hariri, to reaffirm the illegality and illegitimacy of Hezbollah's actions in Lebanon, and to commit the relevant parties to abiding by Lebanon's existing laws," the resolution read. Russia, which has played a key role in the war in Syria, has taken the lead on Middle East issues this year, presenting a series of resolutions, while the United States has been less engaged. In contrast to U.S. ambassador Power, Russia's representative to the Security Council, Vitaly Churkin, said that the assassination and the "Lebanese government's response" was "a coup" by the
